What is Palette?

Palette is a companion App to Photoshop that acts as an artist's palette, allowing the user to mix and create colors as if they were using oil or acrylic paints. Creating a masterpiece has never been more natural.

Palette Points

Syncs over wifi to transfer color and brush information to Photoshop.

Works with Adobe Ink, creating a realistic workflow to digital painting.

Allows Users to customize window selections in App, giving them unlimited customization options for how they want to work.

Syncs User Interface options to Creative Cloud, allowing User to have their preferences across multiple tablets.

Exclusively for painting, and brushwork. Doesn't overlap other segments like Adobe Sketch and Adobe Line
